

# DONMAR FUNSPORT® Pop-Up Sunroof Warranty

## LIMITED "LIFETIME" WARRANTY

DONMAR Enterprises, Inc. warrants **FUNSPORT Pop-Up Sunroofs** against defective materials, workmanship and water leakage between the glass and mainseal while under normal use and service, for as long as you, the original purchaser, own the vehicle. The sunroof must be properly installed by an Authorized Professional Installation Center. **EXCEPTION:** No vandalism or glass breakage will be covered. *No other express or implied warranties are given and this warranty is limited as follows:*

In the event any covered defect is discovered, the owner must, at his/her own expense, bring the vehicle to the original installer, or nearest DONMAR Authorized Installation Center for correction. DONMAR will repair or replace [at our option] parts found to be defective and subject to such warranty coverage, provided that they were not damaged by alteration, improper use or application, or neglect. It is the responsibility of the installation center to perform all warranty services.

This warranty does not apply to any DONMAR product which has been subject to: abuse, misuse, improper use or application, negligence, neglect, accident, flood, fire, or acts of God, nor does it cover loss of time, inconvenience, use of the vehicle, or any other indirect or consequential damages. This warranty is void if repairs have been made or attempted by unauthorized parties. Under no circumstances will labor or installation charges be reimbursed by DONMAR.

**NO OTHER EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES ARE GIVEN INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.**

# FUNSPORT® Pop-Up Sunroof Operation & Maintenance

## OPERATION

**TO OPEN:** Pull locking handle from the rear in a downward, forward motion, clicking latch mechanism into desired position.

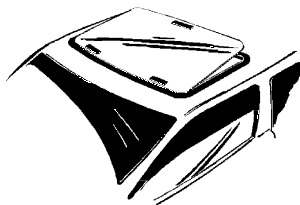
**TO CLOSE:** Press the "PUSH" button with thumb, and reverse the opening procedure with a downward, backward action. Release button in closed and final locking position.

## MAINTENANCE

- Use only mild non-abrasive, non-ammonia glass cleaners to clean the glass panel.
- Clean heavily soiled sunroof frame and seal with a mild solution of soap and water.
- Occasionally lubricate the seal with silicone spray (available at hardware stores).
- Handle and store the glass panel with care.

## WARNING

**DO NOT REMOVE OR REPLACE GLASS WHILE VEHICLE IS MOVING!**

Air drag can pull the glass panel from your grip and result in broken glass, sunroof or vehicle damage, or even bodily injury. Please verify that the panel, hinges and handle are properly seated and locked prior to moving the vehicle.

**REMOVAL OF THE GLASS PANEL:** (1) Open the sunroof panel by operating the handle. (2) Pull down at the center of each hinge block to un-snap the hinge retainer lock mechanisms. (3) Firmly grasp the glass panel with one hand, and squeeze the handle release toggles together with the other. (4) Gently push up on the panel until the handle is released from the pivot base (5) Grasp the panel with both hands and carefully remove it from the frame in an upward and rearward motion. (6) Store the panel in a safe place, free from any object that may scratch or impact the glass. A protective storage bag is recommended. (7) Return the hinge retainers to their snapped closed position.

**TO RE-FIT THE GLASS PANEL:** (1) Pull down at the center of each hinge block to un-snap the hinge retainer lock mechanisms. (2) Grasp the panel firmly at the rear edge, holding it at a slight angle from the vehicle roof. (3) Align the front hinge legs with the retainer blocks and push down on the front edge of the panel with a forward and downward motion until the hinges are fully seated. (4) Return the hinge retainers to their snapped closed and locked position. (5) Align and re-attach the handle mechanism. (6) Gently close the sunroof panel.
